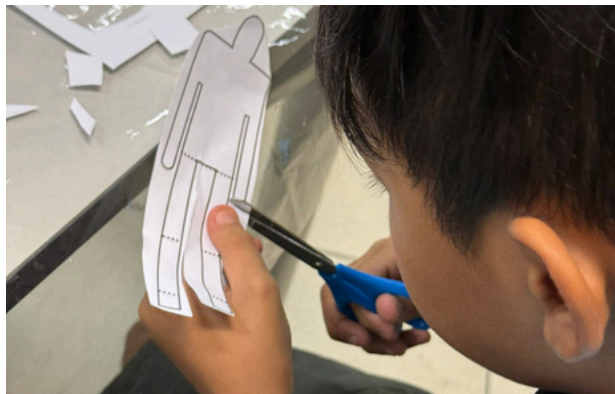
### JANUARY 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

#### A New Creative Chapter with Grace Orchard School



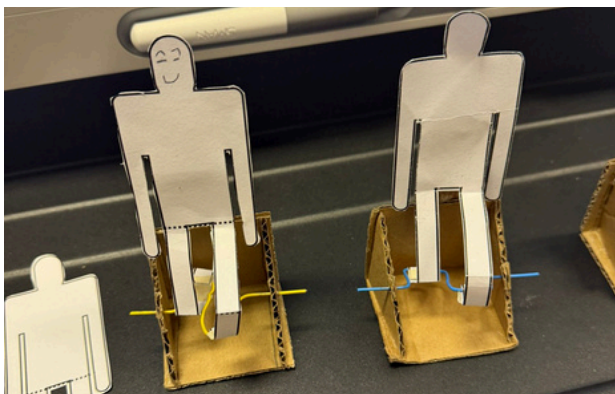
In January 2025, Me2 Centre of Inclusive Arts proudly embarked on an exciting new partnership with Grace Orchard School, bringing our inclusive and vibrant programmes directly into their co-curricular and curriculum-based activities. Grace Orchard School serves students aged 7 to 18 who have been diagnosed with Mild Intellectual Disability (MID), some of whom also have Mild Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD).

Our debut featured two engaging visual arts programmes: STEM Art and Mural Art.



#### STEM Art: Man in Motion (Start of Year: Audition Week)

Students explored the fusion of science, engineering, and creativity through our Man in Motion activity. Using simple mechanical structures and artistic components, they created moving puppets that blended storytelling with technology. This hands-on experience not only sparked their curiosity but also developed fine motor skills and introduced basic engineering principles in a playful and inclusive way.



#### Mural Art: Paint by Numbers (Start of Year: Audition Week)

Our Paint by Numbers mural activity offered students a sense of accomplishment through collaborative art. During the audition week, students used numbered guides to colour intricate designs, learning about teamwork, patience, and visual planning. The mural will grow into a lasting symbol of their voices and vibrancy, proudly displayed within the school. The energy during the audition week was truly inspiring. It was filled with curiosity, enthusiasm, and a spirit of exploration.



Students eagerly immersed themselves in both programmes, showcasing not only their talents but also their openness to learning through creative expression. We're excited to deepen this partnership and remain committed to creating safe, empowering spaces where every student can flourish, both in and beyond the classroom.

**Grace Orchard School is a special education school in Singapore for students aged 7-18 with Mild Intellectual Disability and/or Mild Autism. Run by Presbyterian Community Services, it offers a holistic curriculum including academics, life skills, and vocational training. Her warm presence, playful instructions, and engaging rhythm-based activities had the children clapping, jumping, and expressing themselves with joyful abandon.

But Little Groovers is more than just fun and movement, it's a purposeful, inclusive dance programme designed to meet the developmental needs of young children of all abilities. Through music, rhythm, and creative expression, Little Groovers helps children develop gross motor coordination, spatial awareness, listening skills, social-emotional confidence, and above all, a positive relationship with their bodies and peers.

In a time when early childhood environments are increasingly fast-paced and outcome-driven, the importance of safe, expressive, and movement-rich spaces cannot be overstated.

Programmes like Little Groovers offer more than enrichment—they offer children the chance to slow down, explore their bodies, connect with others, and find their own voice through movement.

These ranged from increasing public engagement with our programmes to improving outreach for persons with disabilities and youths at risk. SMU students were then grouped to brainstorm and develop innovative solutions, which they later pitched to us in a series of thoughtful and engaging presentations.

This partnership was not just an opportunity for us to share our mission, but also a chance to offer students a lens into the complexities of real-world social impact work. It pushed them to think critically, apply their academic knowledge, and engage empathetically with the realities of inclusive education, arts accessibility, and sustainable programme development. What impressed us deeply was the professionalism, creativity, and commitment displayed by the students. Their ideas were not only thoughtful and well-researched but often challenged us to see our own work through a new perspective. The energy in the room during the final presentation day was infectious, a testament to the power of co-creation and community partnerships.

#### Beyond Borders: An Exchange of Inclusive Minds and Creative Hearts



In February 2025, Me2 Centre of Inclusive Arts hosted an extraordinary cultural and educational exchange programme, “Beyond Borders”.

This week-long initiative brought together passionate educators, artists, and advocates from Hong Kong and Singapore, each united by a common goal: to explore and advance inclusive practices through the arts.

From 10 to 14 February, participants immersed themselves in a dynamic lineup of masterclasses, classroom observations, and collaborative sessions.

Hosted at Me2, this exchange was more than an event, it was a movement of connection, reflection, and co-creation.

#### Our Theme: Collaborating for Impact

The heart of the exchange was built on collaboration. Each session offered a unique lens into inclusive teaching: how it looks, feels, and evolves when rooted in empathy, creativity, and lived experience.

Participants had the chance to:

- Engage in masterclasses on inclusive dance, drama, and arts education
- Observe real Me2 classrooms in action
- Deepen their understanding of adaptive strategies
- Build connections with fellow changemakers across borders

#### Featured Educators & Masterclasses

Mabel (Director, Strategy and Inclusive Arts) led two compelling masterclasses: From Chaos to Connection: Mastering the Classroom Flow & Window into Inclusivity: Understand, Engage, Adapt. Her sessions emphasized how structure, empathy, and creative flow can transform a classroom into a space of empowerment.

Lugman (Head of Dance and Movement) inspired attendees through The Art of Deconstruct, showing how to break down dance into accessible, sensory-friendly movement pathways for students of all abilities.

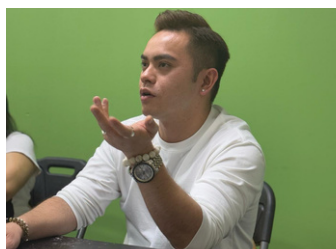
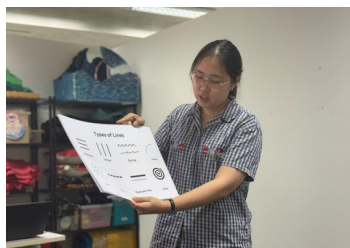

#### Drama with Me2 – Building Confidence, One Role at a Time



At Me2 Centre of Inclusive Arts, we believe that talent knows no bounds and that everyone deserves a stage to shine. That's the spirit behind Drama with Me2, our signature talent development programme designed to train and empower individuals with disabilities in the art of performance.

Rooted in the values of inclusion, expression, and excellence, Drama with Me2 goes beyond basic drama exercises. It is a structured, progressive programme that nurtures each participant's voice, presence, and confidence, on and off the stage. From learning how to embody a character to mastering storytelling techniques and stage movement, participants receive professional-level training tailored to their abilities and learning styles.

But this programme isn't just about acting. It's about unlocking creative potential, fostering teamwork, and building a strong sense of identity and self-belief. Each session is a safe space where students are seen as artists first, encouraged to take risks, explore emotions, and find their unique rhythm in the world of theatre.

What sets Drama with Me2 apart is its commitment to public performance opportunities. Students don't just rehearse, they perform. Whether it's a community stage, a school event, or a public festival, our participants step into the spotlight and showcase their talents to live audiences. These moments are transformative not just for the performers, but for the audiences who witness the power of inclusive arts in action.

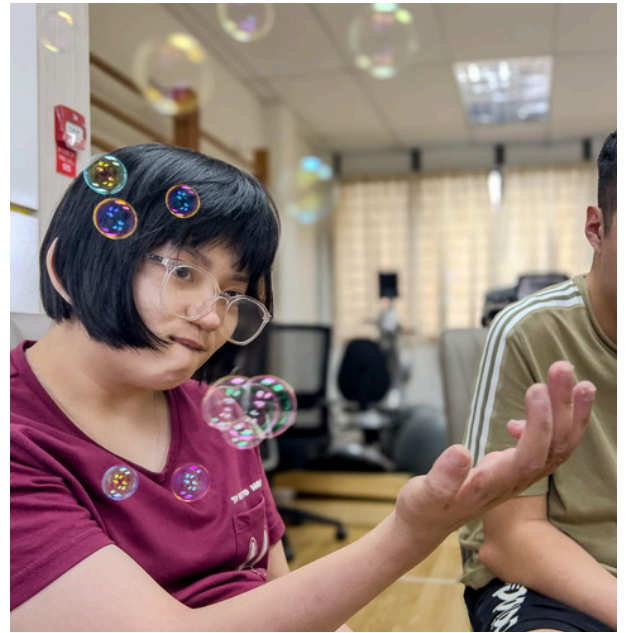
Every line spoken, every movement on stage, is a declaration: We belong. We are capable. We are artists.

### MARCH 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

#### Sensory Expressions – Where Every Emotion Finds a Voice



For individuals with moderate to severe disabilities, expressing emotions and making sense of the world around them can be challenging but not impossible. That's why we created Sensory Expressions, a drama programme designed to support emotional understanding and regulation through multisensory, movement-based storytelling.

Sensory Expressions is grounded in the belief that everyone deserves a safe space to feel, express, and connect, regardless of verbal ability or mobility. Each session is intentionally crafted to engage the senses, using music, texture, rhythm, movement, visuals, and voice to create meaningful experiences that help students explore emotions like joy, sadness, fear, excitement, and calm.

Under the guidance of trained facilitators who are experienced in working with diverse learners, participants are gently guided through drama-based activities such as guided mirroring, sensory play, expressive movement, and emotion role-play.

Through repetition, routine, and imaginative play, students begin to recognise their own emotional cues and develop tools to self-regulate in a supportive environment. Some may show it through a smile and extended eye contact, others through a stomp, a spin, or a hand gesture.

Sensory Expressions is not about getting it "right" in class. It's about the quiet wins, the moment a student recognises their own feelings, mirrors a peer, or chooses to express rather than withdraw. It's about showing that emotional growth is possible when we meet learners exactly where they are.

With each session, we're reminded that expression has no fixed form and that drama, at its core, is about connection, empathy, and presence.

### MARCH 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

#### Roll with Me2 - Defying the lens of Movement



Roll with Me2 is our dedicated movement and expression programme for persons who use wheelchairs, created with one powerful belief in mind: everyone can move, everyone can dance, and everyone deserves to feel the joy of movement.

Too often, movement and dance are seen through a narrow lens, defined by agility, speed, or physical coordination. Roll with Me2 flips that narrative. In this programme, movement is about presence, intention, rhythm, and connection. Participants are encouraged to explore the expressive capabilities of their bodies and their wheelchairs, discovering new ways to communicate, emote, and celebrate their individuality through motion.

Led by our Head of Dance and Movement, Luqman, each session is structured to be both accessible and empowering. Using music, guided imagery, and creative improvisation, students are introduced to body awareness, adapted to their range of motion and comfort level.

But Roll with Me2 is more than a physical programme, it's an emotional and social one. Participants gain confidence, self-awareness, and a sense of camaraderie. They learn to lead and follow, to express joy or frustration through movement, and to connect with others in a space where every form of expression is valid and celebrated.

For some participants, this may be their first opportunity to explore dance. For others, it's a return to joy that they never thought possible. Regardless of where they begin, Roll with Me2 becomes a space of discovery, healing, and freedom.

#### Bringing Movement, Music, and Meaning to Good Space: “Move with Me2” at SAAC



At Me2 Centre of Inclusive Arts, we believe in the transformative power of the arts especially when it is shared, supported, and co-experienced with the people who matter most. That belief is at the heart of “Move with Me2,” a movement and music programme specially designed for individuals with moderate to severe autism, now running at SAAC’s Good Space.

Good Space, a unique initiative by St. Andrew’s Autism Centre (SAAC), offers a safe, structured, and nurturing environment for adults who are alumni of SAAC or are waiting to join a Day Activity Centre.

What sets this programme apart is its caregiver-participation model. Each participant attends alongside a caregiver, be it a parent, sibling, or support staff, forming a dyad that moves together, learns together, and experiences joy together. This shared journey not only strengthens bonds but also creates a consistent and supportive learning experience that carries over into everyday life.

For individuals with more complex needs, finding programmes that offer both structure and creativity can be a challenge. Move with Me2 fills this gap with an approach that respects routine while inviting self-expression. Participants respond not only to the activities but also to the gentle, affirming presence of their caregivers and facilitators.

Over time, we’ve seen increased engagement, improved body awareness, and even moments of spontaneous joy.

**St. Andrew’s Autism Centre (SAAC) in Singapore provides specialized services for individuals with autism and their families. SAAC’s mission is to enable people with autism to live dignified and meaningful lives through their various services.**

**SAAC’s services include a special education school (SAAS), day activity centers (DACs), and a residential home (SAAH), the first of its kind in Singapore for adults with autism.**

### MARCH 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

#### Mural Programme Blossoms at Grace Orchard School



A once plain wall at Grace Orchard School has now been transformed into a vibrant, living symbol of growth, faith, and collaboration. This transformation is thanks to the heart, hands, and imaginations of students who brought it to life through our Paint with Me2 Mural Programme.

Over the course of two school terms, what began as an idea bloomed into a joyful garden-themed mural featuring bright blooms, playful butterflies, and a powerful verse from Colossians 2:7: "Let your roots grow down into Him, and let your lives be built on Him."

What makes this mural truly special is not just its beauty, but its journey. It was not merely an art project, it was a carefully curated process of connection, learning, and purpose.

Led by Wei Yi, our dedicated Curriculum Developer and Teaching Specialist, the programme was designed with intention. Understanding the diverse learning needs of each student, Wei Yi broke the project down into accessible and meaningful stages. From the earliest sketches to the final brushstrokes, each moment was scaffolded with care, ensuring that every student, regardless of ability, could participate meaningfully.

Students practiced outlining flower shapes, mixing colours, and painting in layers, skills that subtly wove together planning, coordination, creativity, and fine motor development. But more than technical skills, what was cultivated was confidence. Each student was trusted to contribute. Each handprint left a mark. Each mistake was met with encouragement and re-framing. The wall slowly transformed but so did the artists.

While the mural's cheerful colours and charming symbols capture attention, it's the deeper meaning that lingers. This wasn't just about beautifying a space, it was about anchoring learning in the values of faith, growth, and community. The garden theme was chosen deliberately to mirror the school's nurturing spirit, with the watering can cheekily marked "G.O.S." (Grace Orchard School) to represent how the school waters and nourishes its students like rain on fertile soil.

### MAY 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

#### Mural Programme Blossoms at Grace Orchard School



There is poetry in how the students painted seeds, roots, and blossoms, symbolising not just the growth of plants, but their own. Many of the students involved had never participated in a mural project before. Some were hesitant. Some took time to find their rhythm. But in time, all bloomed.

Today, the finished mural stands proudly as a daily reminder of what's possible when we create with care and intention. It's a story frozen in paint, but alive in spirit. Teachers pause to admire it. Students smile when they pass it, proudly pointing out "their" flower.

This mural is more than decoration, it's a declaration. A message that growth comes not only from within but also through love, support, and the courage to create together.

At Me2 Centre of Inclusive Arts, we believe art belongs to everyone. Our Paint with Me2 programme exemplifies how inclusive arts can turn any wall into a space of transformation, storytelling, and shared pride.

The Grace Orchard School mural is just one example of how we bring people of all abilities together to co-create something bigger than themselves.

#### Year 2 of Our Progressive Community Living Skills Programme at Sundac CCK



Our “Improv with Me2” programme at Sundac Choa Chu Kang is now in Year 2 of a 3-year progressive curriculum, designed to build essential communication and community living skills for adults with moderate to severe disabilities. What began in Year 1 with foundational improvisational tools like self-expression, turn-taking, and making choices, is now evolving into practical, real-world applications.

In the current module, students are learning to recognise healthy choices, particularly in daily scenarios like grocery shopping.

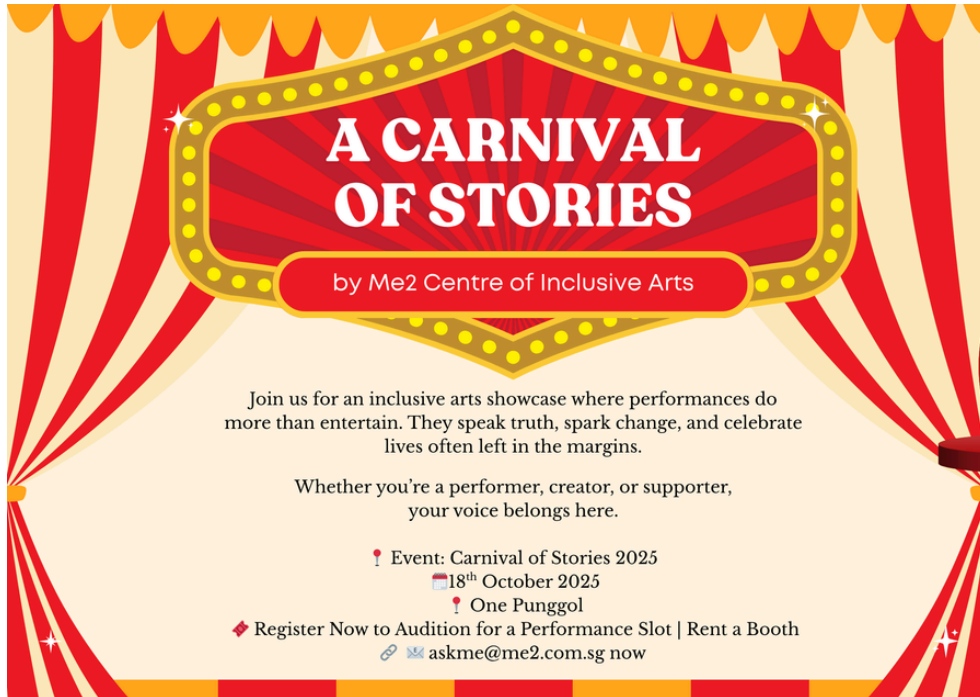
The lesson sequence is structured around role-play, visual cues, and hands-on learning, and this term culminated in a learning journey to the supermarket, a highlight for both participants and facilitators.

As pictured above, students practiced identifying health symbols, sugar ratings, and product categories, applying what they’ve learned in a dynamic, sensory-rich environment. Each participant carried their own visual list, checked for labels, and made conscious decisions with guidance from their trainers. The trip wasn’t just educational, it was empowering.

Many of the students beamed with pride as they carried their baskets down the aisles, confidently pointing out “Healthier Choice” symbols and understanding what they meant. For some, this was their first time taking charge of what they selected off the shelf. For others, it was a meaningful chance to generalise classroom learning in a real-life context.

#### A Carnival of Stories 2025



2025 marks a bold new chapter for Me2 Centre of Inclusive Arts with the launch of our flagship inclusive arts event, A Carnival of Stories. A one-day, multi-disciplinary experience dedicated to amplifying the voices that are often left in the background.

Rooted in our ongoing initiative, **No Longer in the Background**, this carnival is more than just a showcase, it's a statement. It challenges the traditional narrative of the arts by centering artists with disabilities, caregivers, and those whose lived experiences are rarely seen or heard in the mainstream. It's not about token inclusion, it's about integration, equity, and celebration.

Set to take place at One Punggol, A Carnival of Stories will feature a rich blend of music, movement, spoken word, dramatic monologues, theatre, panel discussions, and interactive booths. It will bring together diverse performers across all disciplines and abilities to tell stories that matter—unfiltered, raw, and real.

At the heart of the event lies our four-pillar narrative framework, which guides the artistic direction of the day:

- **The Unheard:** Stories that have been silenced or ignored, brought to life through spoken word, rap, and monologue.
- **The Unseen:** Performances by those hidden in plain sight, “caregivers, persons with disabilities, neurodivergent voices”, through dance and visual storytelling.
- **The Unspoken:** Dramatic pieces and panel discussions exploring themes of grief, trauma, and mental health.
- **The Undoing:** A space of joyful defiance and transformation, celebrating identity, dignity, and hope through collaboration and ensemble performances.

#### A Carnival of Stories 2025



One Punggol is a vibrant community hub at the heart of Punggol, created to bring people together through inclusive spaces, meaningful experiences, and shared resources.

Adding depth to the carnival is The Living Legacy Mural, a permanent installation at Punggol Atrium. To be created with and by artists with disabilities, this public artwork will feature four interconnected panels reflecting each narrative pillar, standing as a lasting tribute to the stories shared during the event.

In an exciting partnership, AAG has adopted A Carnival of Stories as the official cause for their inaugural intervarsity annual dance competition, a collaboration that blends the power of storytelling with the passion of movement.

Open to tertiary institutions across Singapore, the competition invites student dance crews to interpret the event's four narrative pillars: The Unheard, The Unseen, The Unspoken, and The Undoing, through original choreography and performance. This isn't just a contest; it's a creative call to action. Dancers are encouraged to go beyond technique, tapping into lived experiences and untold stories that challenge, heal, and transform.

Each team may register with up to 10 members, with a registration fee of \$250 per team. Beyond prestige and purpose, there are significant cash prizes to be won:

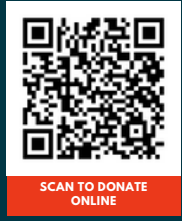
